In Santander city we can find this park with a series of elements that makes it an eco-inclusive space for everyone.

First of all, we can start by highlighting that it is an accessible park for all kinds of people, since it is located on a flat area. Therefore, children can get there on foot, in a wheelchair or with some element that is necessary to facilitate their mobility. In this way, barriers are being eliminated for the presence of all people. In addition, not only the presence is favored, but also the participation and access to some play areas is facilitated, for example, to the swivel chairs and swings with protective structure. Furthermore, the playground floor is made of rubber, which prevents severe injuries and allows children to move around safely.

It is located in a residential area away from the city center, so pollution levels are significantly reduced. At the same time, it is also surrounded by green areas, some paths to access them, perfect for walking and being in contact with nature, and a supply of drinking water.

It is also worth mentioning that it is located far from the road, so car traffic is not very common.

Finally, it is noteworthy that this park has LED lighting that allows good visibility when it gets dark early in the evening. Besides, it is built with environmentally friendly materials, such as the rubber previously mentioned, and recycled plastic materials, as the ones used in the roof, which protects the children and allows them to enjoy playing and entertaining themselves in any season of the year and in any weather conditions.
